I. Demon Facts:

- A. Greek transliteration is "Daimon", meaning Devil. Used once in scripture; "Daimonion" is the transliteration used 60+ times meaning demon or evil spirit. Referred to as "unclean" or "evil" spirits.
- B. Commonly referred to as "unclean" or "evil" spirits.
- C. King James and Authorized Version translates "demons" as "devils (Combined Demon + Evil to equal Devil.)

II. Who or What?

- A. They are spiritual beings at enmity with God. (Matt.8:16; 10:1; 12:43-45)
- B. Belong to the kingdom of Satan (Matt.25:41)
- C. Ancient writers labeled them as Fallen Angels
- D. Created with choice, but no plan for redemption (Job 4:18b)
- E. Recognize Jesus (Mk.5:1-13; Matt 8:29-32)
- F. Have a certain power over man. (Ma.8:20; L.4:41)
- G. Part of "Principalities and Powers" at war with man (Eph 6:12)
- H. One was called "Legion", who's ultimate detention will be the "abyss" (Lk. 8:30)

- A. Belong to a group of angels who voluntarily abandoned their "proper domain" (Jude 6)
- B. "Lake of Fire & Brimstone"- reserved for them (Matt. 25:41)
- C. Jesus spoke of demons passing thru 'waterless places" (Matt 12:43)
- D. Ancient Babylon beliefs influenced later generations of Jew and Greek
 - 1. Many Babylonian texts still exist of incantations
 - 2. Jewish Rabbinical texts on exorcisms.
- E. Believed to live in abandon cities, empty houses, or remote areas.
- F. Thought to change appearances, sometimes human, or animal form.
- G. Believed to stalk or ambush travelers
