One of the most tragic sections of the Bible – chapters 8-11

8:1-6 – Sadness at the north gate of the inner court of the temple

- Where was Ezekiel when the vision came to him?
- Who was with Ezekiel?
- What had been placed at the north of the altar gate?
- God was to show Ezekiel still greater \_\_\_\_\_

8:7-18

- ❖ What did Ezekiel see when he dug through a hole in the wall of the temple?
- ❖ Three times in this chapter God told Ezekiel that he would see even greater \_\_\_\_\_ than he had previously seen
- ❖ Beyond the religious abominations, God said the Israelites had filled the land with \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ Because of these things God said he would have no \_\_\_\_\_ in his wrath

9:1-11
