The prophet Haggai served in about 520BC during the building of the second temple following the return of the exiles to Jerusalem from Babylon.
He is mentioned along with the prophet by Ezra at 5:1 & 6:14 as being instrumental in successfully completing the temple.
In Haggai's time, was the king of Persia, Zerubbabel was the governor of & Joshua was the high priest.
Haggai 1:1-11 – Haggai's work begins as the word of the Lord comes to him in the 2nd year of Darius, king of Persia on the 1st day of the 6th month
1) Haggai's prophetic work is addressed to Zerubbabel & Joshua & begins with a of those who have returned to build because they have begun to give their attention more to their own rather than the house of God. He asks, "Is it time for you yourselves to dwell in your houses while this house sits desolate?"
2) The prophet warns, "You have much, but little. You eat, but there is not enough to be You drink, but there is not enough to become drunk. You put on clothes, but no one is enough and he who earns wages puts them into a purse with" God says what they bring home he will away.
Haggai 1:12-15 3) At Haggai's words the people and show reverence for God. By the commission of God, Haggai then tells the people that God says he is them At this point the Lord stirs up the of Zerubbabel & Joshua and all the people who renew their work on the temple on the 24th day of the 6th month of the same year.
Haggai 2:1-9 4) This time the message of God to Zerubbabel & Joshua on the 21st day of the 7th month begins with three:
a) "Who is left among you who saw this in its former glory? b) "How do you see it now?" c) "Does it not seem to you like in comparison?
