

HEBREWS Chapter 9

I. (OLD) The ALTAR OF BURNT OFFERINGS

-Exod. 27:1-8 describes the altar

-Exod 40:29 describes location. Sacrifices for sins were offered on it.

***I. (NEW) Heb 13:10-12 We have an altar. It is Christ's sacrifice for our sins
Heb 9:26 Jesus sacrificed himself as an offering for sin.***

II. (OLD) THE LAVER: a vessel of brass with water in it for priests to wash their hands and feet.

- Exod 40:7,30 placed in court between altar and tabernacle

Exod 30:17-21 Priests washed before entering the tabernacle

II. (NEW) In the New Testament we must also be washed in water before we enter the church. As the priest had to come by the altar of burnt offerings and wash in the Laver before entering the Holy Place, just so men today go by the altar, or sacrifice of Christ and be born of water (baptism) and the Spirit before they enter the church.

***Titus 3:5 / John 3:5 men must be "born of water" to enter the kingdom
Heb 10:22 / Eph 5:26 must have their bodies washed with the washing water by the Word.***

III. (OLD) THE LAMPSTAND

Exod 37:17-24 provided the light in the Holy Place for the priests

Exod40:24 - located in the Holy Place & was the only light for the room

***III. (NEW) We too have a lamp and light
Psalm 119:105 word of God is a "lamp" and "light"***

IV. (OLD) TABLE OF SHOWBREAD

Lev 24:5-9 Bread on this table was eaten on Sabbath Day by the priests, after they had been by the altar of burnt offerings and the laver.

Exod 40:22 Located in the Holy Place of Tabernacle

IV. (NEW) The Lord's Supper is eaten by New Testament Priests on the first day of every week. The Table of Showbread was a type of Lord's Supper. Only after going by the sacrifice of Christ, and by the laver of baptism, are men to eat the Lord's Supper.

Matt: 26:24 The Lord's Supper is to be eaten in the Kingdom (Church).

Acts 20:7 In Troas, they met on 1st day of week to break bread.

***I Peter 2:9 / Rev 1:6 All Christians are priests in the New Testament Church
And they are the ones who have privilege of eating the Supper.***

V. (OLD) THE ALTAR OF INCENSE

Exod 40:26-27 located in the Holy Place of Tabernacle.

Exod 30:1-10 Priests burned incense on it every morning & evening. Stood before the veil
In front of Most Holy Place so that when incense was burned, the fragrance
Penetrated the veil and permeated the Most Holy Place.

***V. (NEW) In the church, the incense is the prayers of the saints. The incense offered
On The altar of incense was a type of the prayers of Christian priests.
Rev 5:8 the incense offered in the new Testament are the "prayers of the saints".
Matt 6:9 Prayers of believers penetrate into Heaven just like incense penetrated
Into The Most Holy Place***

****The Most Holy Place in the tabernacle was a type of Heaven in the New Testament.**

VI. THE RED HEIFER

(OLD) Num 19. Red Heifer was sacrificed outside the camp to attain purification for anyone
who had come into contact with a dead body.

***VI. (NEW) Jesus was sacrificed outside Jerusalem to attain purification for those
Who (us) have come into contact with sin (death).***
