**"..... and you shall know that I am the Lord"** – each of the following passages repeats this idea

Exodus 6:1-9 – God tells Moses that the \_\_\_\_\_ will see who he is through what he will do for them.

Exodus 7:4-5 – God says the \_\_\_\_\_ will know that he is God when he stretches out his hand on them and their nation.

Exodus 7:14-18 – God says \_\_\_\_\_ will know that he is God when strikes the Nile

## Israel comes to Mount Sinai

Exodus 19:1-9 – Moses and the sons of Israel reach Sinai in the \_\_\_\_\_ month after leaving Egypt. God calls Moses up to the mountain and tells him that three things will happen if Israel will \_\_\_\_\_ him and keep his covenant:

- 1) They will be God's \_\_\_\_\_ among all \_\_\_\_\_
- 2) They will be a kingdom of \_\_\_\_\_

Moses comes down to the people and meeting with the \_\_\_\_\_ sets before them all the words of God, to which the people respond saying that all the Lord says, \_\_\_\_\_.

### Exodus 19:10-15

God instructs Moses to tell the people to \_\_\_\_\_ themselves over the next \_\_\_\_\_ days, and to \_\_\_\_\_ their clothes and to be ready for God to come down on the mountain the \_\_\_\_\_ day. The consecration also required that during that time, no man would touch a woman. Neither man nor beast are to \_\_\_\_\_ the mountain on pain of \_\_\_\_\_. Boundaries were to be set so that when the ram's horns were sounded the people could gather at the foot of the mountain at a \_\_\_\_\_ distance.

### Exodus 19:16-25
